Description: Change is the name of the coding game and 2020 will be no different! The new coding year begins October 1 and we have new codes and guidelines **PLUS** a new payment system, **PDGM**, effective January 1, 2020. This class will start with a coding update followed by a complete explanation of diagnosis coding in PDGM. Common misunderstandings will be clarified with plenty of scenarios and tools to increase accuracy.

Lack of training leads to denials, upcoding, or downcoding leading to decreased cash flow. Increase your knowledge and understanding and gain the expertise your agency needs to survive the 2020 changes. With government auditors targeting home care, now is the time to ensure that you are coding correctly and protecting your revenue.
