

## Key OASIS-D in a Day

**Description:** This OASIS-D one day class is a crash course designed to update clinicians on the most current OASIS-D information, with a focus on assessment strategies and guidance tips for accurate data collection and response selection. While not all OASIS items will be covered, it will address items used for reimbursement under the new **PDGM** model and quality measurement, the GG items, and items that have presented challenges for clinicians in the past. The **OASIS-D1** changes coming January 2020 will also be outlined. Examples will be used to illustrate concepts and guide you through application scenarios that are typical for home health patients. This workshop will provide attendees with the latest key OASIS resources and references in electronic format that can be used after the workshop to maintain a current comprehensive knowledge of OASIS.
